Beloved in Christ,  
**Thank you** for all your prayers, spiritual bouquets, and Easter greetings in this glorious season!

**Decline to sign!** In the coming weeks, we will hear more about Archbishop Schnurr's initiative to join leaders of all backgrounds of faith as we oppose an unthinkable ballot initiative in Ohio. It is deceptively named: "The Right to Reproductive Freedom with Protections for Health and Safety." It sounds like what it would really do is erase the basic rights of parents for consent and notification before minor children would have procedures that mutilate their bodies or kill their unborn grandchild; make it legal to kill the unborn with almost no restrictions; remove the necessity for abortion practitioners to have a transfer agreement to a hospital when things go bad. Visit ([ohiocathconf.org](http://ohiocathconf.org)) for the latest from Ohio's bishops. I will share information with you as I receive it from the Archbishop. Until then, if someone asks us to sign a petition to get this horrendous change to Ohio's constitution on the November ballot, we can simply decline to sign.

### Spiritual Writing Group

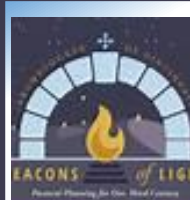
