Please keep our middle schoolers in prayer this week as they participate in Cross Training. May they have a true encounter with Jesus Christ!

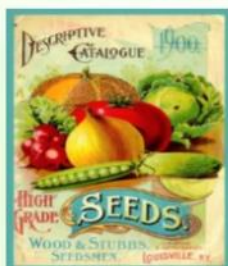

The MHC Community Garden grows and harvests crops to support the St. Vincent de Paul and FISH Food Pantries. Many volunteers, including our PSR youth, parishioners and Greene County Master Gardeners work in the MHC Garden. Some of the beautiful flowers in our sanctuary at church in the summer and fall months come from this garden.



We work in the garden most Thursdays throughout the growing

season starting at 9:00AM. **Please join us as volunteers are needed and always welcome.**

We did not keep produce weight totals for 9 of the 26 years we have been maintaining this garden. But our best estimate is 27,500 pounds of fresh garden produce that have been donated to the food pantries. During its peak season, the Garden produced 1,950 pounds of fresh produce which includes a whopping 796 pounds of tomatoes.

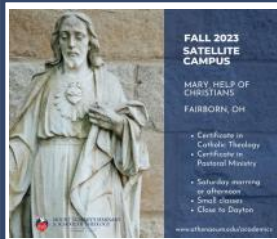

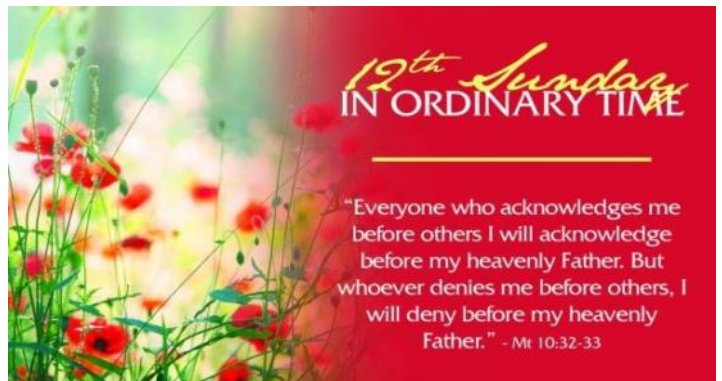

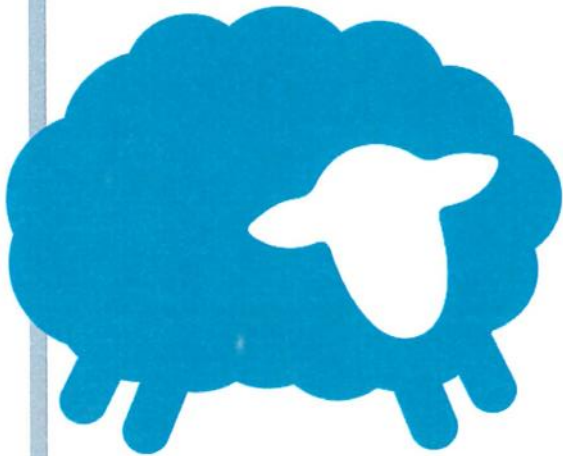
