Love is the only acceptable response.

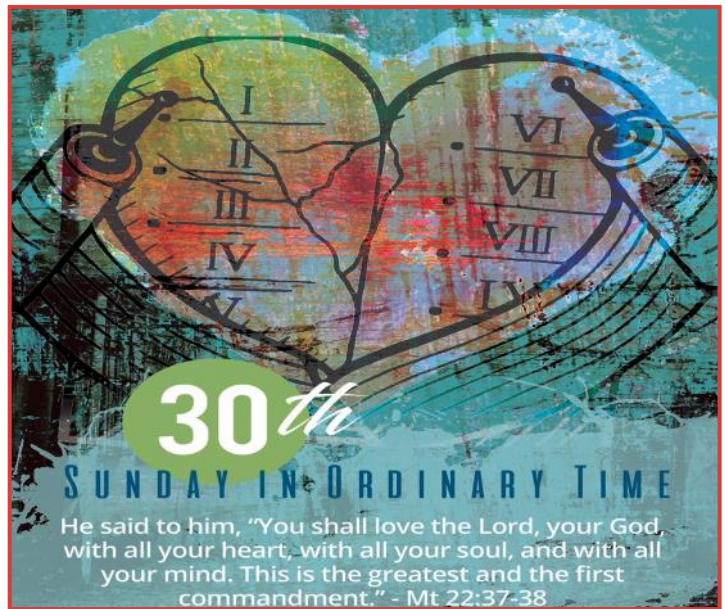
Mary, Help of Christians
